The Piano

In addition to being a beautiful piece of furniture, the piano is a complex musical instrument with over 220 strings and a combined string tension load of over 35,000 lbs. The inner mechanism... called the action... is assembled with thousands of intricate springs, levers, and pads made from wood, metals, leather, wool felts, high tech carbon fiber, and other materials. It has been designed and engineered for over 300 years to bring you a unique acoustic sound and touch.

While electronic synthesizers may approximate the sound of an acoustic piano, they cannot approach the true beauty of the real thing.

Basic Rules of Piano Care

- Keep your piano in tune – at a minimum yearly. Piano teachers, music studios, churches, schools, concert pianist require more frequent care
- Keep your piano clean.
- Maintain the piano's finish.
- Maintain the inner working of the piano.
- Maintain a fairly consistent temperature and humidity control.
- Play your piano regularly.
- Keep all liquids off of the piano.
- Select a piano technician with care.
- Use a professional piano mover.



Servicing the Piano

Use an experienced, full-time, registered piano technician (RPT). A series of rigid testing must be completed to obtain a registered certification through the Piano Technician's Guild, which is a national non-profit organization of skilled craftsmen involved in continuing education through regular meetings and seminars. A seasoned pro that does this for a living will have all the special tools, knowledge, and advice to help keep your piano performing at its best. They can also work more efficiently, and make the proper recommendations to save you money in the long run.
